The Mayor announced that a petition for a recount of the accepted non-provisional ballots cast for members of the Town Council was received, along with payment for the bond. There was no request to recount the votes cast for Mayor and Recorder. The Town Council, sitting as the Board of Canvassers, monitors the recount but may not participate during the recount process.

The counting team opened the ballot box with a key and removed several sealed envelopes, including one with the counted and accepted ballots. A tally sheet of the results from the Board of Canvassers meeting was also presented. The envelopes were opened and acknowledged by those present.
